

**Greater Wellington Regional Council Movin'March WOW Passport Competition 2020
Terms and Conditions**

Due to COVID-19 lockdown disruptions impacting on schools being open, the date for returning all WOW Passports to GWRC has been extended to Mon 11th May 2020

1. The Movin'March WOW Passport Competition (**Competition**) is run by Greater Wellington Regional Council of 15 Walter Street, Te Aro, Wellington 6011 (**GWRC**). The Competition will be governed by these Terms and Conditions and by entering this Competition, you (**you, your or Entrant**) are deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions.
2. The Competition is open to any child attending a school in the Wellington region including Wairarapa, Upper Hutt, Hutt Valley, Wellington central, Porirua and Kapiti, (the **Region**) that is registered on the Movin'March website www.movinmarch.com (the **Website**) with the exception of immediate family members of the GWRC Travel Choice team (**Eligible Entrant**).
3. If you are younger than 18 years of age, you must have the consent of your parent or legal guardian to enter this Competition.

Competition Period

4. The Competition will commence on 12:01am on Monday 2nd March 2020 and end at 11:59pm on Tuesday 31 March 2020 (**Competition Period**).

Entry

5. To enter the Competition, each Entrant must:
 - (a) collect at least 1 stamp, clip or signature on an official Movin'March passport card from an authorised school representative for walking or wheeling to or from school;
 - (b) complete all details on the reverse of the Movin'March passport card; and
 - (c) submit the Movin'March passport card to the return address on the card, either by post or by returning it to your school to post so that it is received by GWRC before the end of the Competition Period.

during the Competition Period (each, an **Entry**).

6. The Movin'March passport cards allow a maximum of 10 stamps, clips or signatures and when a card has 10 it is deemed to be a **Completed Card**. You may submit:
 - (a) as many Completed Cards as you wish; and

- (b) a maximum of two Movin'March passport cards that have fewer than 10 stamps, clips or signatures,

during the Competition Period. However, each Entrant can win only one prize.

- 7. You are responsible for ensuring that any information provided as part of an Entry is complete and correct. Incomplete, incorrect, indecipherable, illegible or late entries will be invalid.
- 8. GWRC reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of Entries and Entrants (including an Entrant's identity, age, school and place of residence) and to disqualify any Entrant who submits an Entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Failure by GWRC to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

Draw

- 9. Within 11 business days of the end of the Competition Period, GWRC will separate all valid Entries into the six districts within the Wellington Region based on the Entrant's school location. GWRC will then randomly select one Entry from all the valid Entries received during the Competition Period in each district (**Winning Entry**) to give a total of twelve Winning Entries (two per district).
- 10. GWRC will use its best endeavours to contact each winner by phone or email using the school contact details supplied in each Winning Entry within 5 business days from the prize draw. However, if GWRC cannot contact any winner within a reasonable time, GWRC may redraw for the relevant prize.
- 11. Where any winner is younger than 18 years of age, GWRC may award the prize to the winner's parent or legal guardian. GWRC may require the winner's parent or guardian to sign acceptance of these Terms and Conditions prior to claiming a prize.
- 12. The winners may be announced on the GWRC Movin'March Facebook page on or about Friday 15 May 2020.
- 13. All decisions regarding this Competition by GWRC will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Prize(s)

- 14. The prizes for the competition will be 12 x My Ride vouchers – two for each of the Winning Entries in the six districts in the Wellington region. Prizes are valued at \$400 each and are issued from My Ride Stores redeemable at any of the four My Ride stores in the Wellington region (Wellington city, Lower Hutt and Masterton). Prizes will be sent to the winners' schools for awarding.

15. The prizes cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
16. GWRC will use its best endeavours to provide the prizes set out in these Terms and Conditions. If any of the prizes are unavailable for whatever reason, GWRC reserves the right to substitute the prize for a prize of an equivalent value.
17. By entering the Competition, you agree to GWRC using your personal information supplied to contact you if you are a prize winner. If you are a prize winner, you agree to participate in publicity organised by GWRC and you also agree to the use of your name, likeness and image for publicity and promotional purposes for an unlimited period in any media, without compensation. This includes, but is not limited to, social media and event websites and media releases.

General

18. Subject to any applicable laws which cannot be excluded, GWRC, its employees and agents will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury of any nature incurred or suffered by any person (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss or loss arising from negligence) arising directly or indirectly out of or in connection with this Competition or with winning, redeeming or benefiting from the prize.
19. You understand that you are providing your information to GWRC and the information you provide will be collected, stored and used only for the purpose of this Competition and as otherwise set out in (and in accordance with) [GWRC's Privacy Statement](#).
20. GWRC, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to cancel, suspend, terminate or modify the Competition if fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond GWRC's reasonable control adversely affects GWRC's ability to conduct the Competition as contemplated in these Terms and Conditions, subject to any written directions from any regulatory authority. Any such termination or modification will be notified on the Movin'March website.
21. These terms and conditions shall be governed by the laws of New Zealand and each Entrant agrees to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of New Zealand.
